The Board of Regents, State of Iowa, will meet for a Strategic Planning session on Monday, February 2, 2009, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., at the Courtyard by Marriott, 2405 S.E. Creekview Drive, Ankeny, Iowa. The purpose of the session is to continue the process for developing a long-term Board of Regents Strategic Plan.

The Board's discussion will be facilitated by Mr. Dennis Jones, President of the National Center of Higher Education Management Systems (NCHEMS), a nonprofit research and development center founded to improve strategic decision making in institutions and agencies of higher education. Mr. Jones is a well-known expert on higher education strategic planning, with 30 years of experience consulting with hundreds of public and private institutions and state higher education agencies in virtually all 50 states, including Arizona, Kentucky, Texas, Minnesota, and Nevada, as well as the Education Commission of the States.
