## PROPOSED NON-TUITION-RELATED MISCELLANEOUS FEES FOR FY 2009

**Actions Requested:** Give preliminary consideration to:

- Proposed changes to non-tuition-related miscellaneous fees for FY 2009 as illustrated on page 2.
- File a notice to amend the administrative rules to increase the University of Northern Iowa's undergraduate application fee from \$30 to \$40.

<u>Executive Summary</u>: The Board reviews non-tuition-related miscellaneous fees for the coming academic year after acting upon tuition rates, which occurred in December. Approval of the proposals in this memorandum is scheduled for Board action at its June meeting. The universities would use the new fee schedule for FY 2009.

Miscellaneous fees include both tuition-related and non-tuition-related fees:

- Tuition-related fees are presented with the Board's annual discussion of tuition and mandatory fees and include items such as continuing education courses and workshops. These fees are in lieu of tuition.
- Non-tuition-related fees are presented in the spring. Non-tuition-related fees include items such as
  course delivery fees and private music lessons. In each category, students pay only the
  miscellaneous fees that apply to them, with variances in type and amount dependent on each
  student's program, needs, and interests. These fees are in addition to tuition.

## For FY 2009:

- The University of Iowa requests approval for three new fees ranging from \$35 to \$1,000; three new R•E•A•C•H fees ranging from \$450 to \$51,000; thirteen fee increases ranging from \$1 to \$200; one fee ratification of \$75; and seven fee eliminations ranging from \$25 to \$720.
- lowa State University requests approval for one fee increase of \$24; and two title revisions;
- The University of Northern Iowa requests twelve fee increases ranging from \$1 to \$44; and three fee eliminations ranging from \$50 to \$316.

University justifications for the new and increased fees and changes to titles are highlighted in Attachment A (pages 3-6) and a comprehensive list of all fees is contained in Attachment B (pages 7-10).

<u>Background</u>: Regent Policy Manual §8.04: (1) requires that the Board review and approve all new institutional or college-wide fees of over \$1 per semester and all departmental fees over \$10 per semester; and (2) encourages the three universities to work together to establish common titles and amounts for miscellaneous fees. Some differences in fee titles and amounts may remain because of the unique nature of some programs and services at each institution.

<u>lowa Code</u> §262.9(18) requires the Board to take action no sooner than 30 days after notification of the proposed fee changes to presiding officers of each student government organization at each affected institution. Written notification of the proposed non-tuition-related miscellaneous fees will be mailed to the student government president at each of the universities.

<u>lowa Administrative Code</u> §681-1.7 requires that application fees be modified through the lowa Administrative rules process. The Board Office will prepare and file the proper filings with the Administrative Rules Committee to increase UNI's undergraduate application fee from \$30 to \$40.

### **UNIVERSITY OF IOWA**

#### **EXISTING FEES**

The University proposes to:

- Eliminate the Career Services Fees, Academic Year and Summer Session. The University reports that it has discontinued charging this fee.
- Increase the American Dental Association Dues (Dentistry Fees). This is a passthrough fee for membership to the national organization, which increased its fees effective January 1, 2009.
- Increase the **Instrument Management System Fee** for the entering class of 2008 and **Laboratory Supplies Fee** for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students (Dentistry Fees). The University reports that the increases are based on cost inflation of the services and are within or lower than the projected Higher Education Price Index range (3.2 % to 4.5%) as presented to the Board during the tuition and fees discussion in December 2007.
- Eliminate the **Teaching Assistant Preparation in English (TAPE)** (Developmental Course Fees). Collection of the fee has been suspended.
- Increase the **Diploma Replacement Fee** due to increased costs for paper stock, mailers, and postage.
- Establish a **Dual Degree Fee** for the combined Doctor of Veterinary Medicine/Master of Public Health (DVM/MPH) degree program to assure student equity and recover MPH funding.

The College of Public Health (CPH) offers a dual DVM/MPH degree in collaboration with ISU. Students enroll in the DVM program in the fall and apply for admission to the combined program to begin the following spring semester. MPH students not in combined programs are assessed a tuition supplement of \$6,000. DVM/MPH students take one course per semester through SUI (fall and spring) and are not charged the additional tuition supplement; they pay the SUI tuition supplement only during summer sessions.

DVM/MPH students derive the same benefits as MPH students who pay the full amount, yet do not pay the SUI tuition supplement while enrolled at ISU; they are only assessed half of the total tuition (\$3,000) for SUI summer sessions. The proposed fee is the difference between the actual tuition supplement collected during the summer (\$3,000) and the total tuition supplement the other students pay (\$6,000). The \$3,000 will be collected in \$500 increments each semester.

• Establish a new **Employer Reimbursement Deferred Billing Fee** to fund the administrative costs of deferred billing for students with a valid employer reimbursement contract.

- Increase the **Graduation Fee** to address the inflationary increases of software licensing and maintenance, materials and staff involved in reviewing records and conducting graduation ceremonies, and implementation of a server-based, graduation-analysis product.
- Increase the Late Fee for Applying After Deadline (Graduation Fee) to cover costs associated with increased involvement of staff with students, departments, and colleges for late processing and commencement arrangements.
- Increase the **New Student Programs/Matriculation Fees** to cover increased costs of providing orientation to over 5,500 new freshmen and transfer students and their parents, staff time, salary and fringe benefits, and new initiatives that help the University meet accrediting agencies' requirements.
- Increase the **College of Education e-Portfolio Fee** (Placement Services Fees General) to cover the increased costs of hardware costs, software upgrades, maintenance, and professional services fees. E-Portfolio enables students to demonstrate competency and display work on web sites that the College of Education provides and helps them design.
- Increase the Late, Day 1-5 Fee (Registration Fees) to cover costs associated with the hand entry of course registrations and the filing of paper forms. The University reports that the increased penalty should reduce the number of students that register late.
- Establish an **Administrative Fee** (Study Abroad Fees) to replace the current fee schedule with one fee, which will cover the costs associated with contract development, fee charges, and faculty and staff travel to course sites for supervision. This fee would be for all students who study abroad.
  - Students who participate in University of Iowa study abroad programs will pay additional fees that cover the cost of their study abroad programs, including additional administrative support provided by the Office for Study Abroad. Students who choose to participate in programs sponsored by other institutions use the advising, orientation, and credit transfer services provided by the Office for Study Abroad.
- Increase the **First and Additional Copies** (Transcript Fees) to cover inflationary cost increases and support development of a 24/7 on-line transcript request process for alumni that may include the possibility of same day service through a third party certification process. The University reports that most former students incur transcript fees occasionally and that transparency and delivery speed are important.

## R·E·A·C·H Program

A status report on the R·E·A·C·H Program was presented to the Board at its February meeting.

The University requests that the Board:

- Ratify the R•E•A•C•H Processing Fee for FY 2008 to recover costs associated with review of the 40-page application and required supplemental materials. Materials are reviewed in several phases by office personnel and the admissions committee. Processing includes tracking receipt, time-intensive review of qualitative information for individual consideration, periodic phone and mail communication with families, and campus interviews with families. R•E•A•C•H administrators also provide information, reviews, and referrals to students and families who do not fit the program's general criteria. Processing materials began after the Board's consideration and approval of miscellaneous fees in 2007.
- Increase the R•E•A•C•H Processing Fee for FY 2009. Processing of the fee for the inaugural year was lower than actual costs because the goal was to encourage interest.
- Establish the R•E•A•C•H Acceptance Fee to confirm space in the program and support operating expenses for the two-day orientation. There are a limited number of comparable programs that are fully integrated into a major, public university such as R•E•A•C•H and a highly competitive process is anticipated. The orientation program offers students and families educational presentations, community activities, and meals. Orientation program expenses include personnel and operational expenses. The University notes that it is important to have commitment from the families and students by May 1<sup>st</sup> to prepare for orientation and enrollment and anticipates offering a summer course for incoming students in the future.
- Establish Program Fees for residents and non-residents to cover the costs of operational expenses, continuing curriculum and program development, personnel, marketing, research, R·E·A·C·H course instruction, University student fees, and University tuition for six credits of undergraduate coursework each year.

Proposed program fees for the first two-year program are \$25,000 and \$51,000 for residents and nonresidents, respectively, and will cover academic years FY 2009 and FY 2010. The University reports that: (1) the amounts are comparable to fees at the Pathway Program at UCLA Extension; (2) R·E·A·C·H is the only other program at a major public university; (3) similar private-college programs are typically \$10,000 more; (4) additional sources of public and private funding are being pursued to assist in awarding scholarships, reducing program costs, and funding research projects; and (5) some grants are available to support the program's start-up; and (6) the proposed fee structure will allow the program to be self-sustaining by its fifth year of operation.

### **IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY**

#### **EXISTING FEES**

The University proposes to:

- Revise the Applied Music Fees listing to reflect that these fees are applied by the number of credits enrolled and not by major or non-major.
- Increase **Registration Fees** to remain equivalent with the minimum tuition for two credits at the resident graduate rate for FY 2009 as approved by the Board in December 2007.

#### UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA

### **EXISTING FEES**

The University proposes to:

- Increase **Applied Music Fees** to meet the rising costs for pianists and instrument repairs, which is necessary to sustain excellence in teaching in the School of Music.
- Increase **Developmental Course Fees** to remain equivalent with tuition for two credits at the resident undergraduate rate for FY 2009 as approved by the Board in December 2007.
- Increase the **Microfilm Fee for Doctoral Dissertation** to remain equivalent with the amount the outside vendor charges the University for providing this service.
- Increase annual **Price Laboratory School Fees** using the increase in undergraduate resident tuition approved by the Board in December 2007 as a base percentage.
- Eliminate two Price Laboratory School Fees: Price School Student Fee and Non-Price School Student Fee. These fees were assessed for driver's education instruction and will now be collected directly by the outside vendor.
- Eliminate the **Student Teaching Fee** to follow the practice of the other Regent universities and consider this as a course fee.

### Administrative Rules Change:

Last year, the UNI proposed and the Board approved an increase to UNI's undergraduate application fee from \$30 to \$40 effective FY 2008. The increased funds were used for new recruitment initiatives and new student programming, including e-communication and web services. <a href="Lowa Administrative Code">Lowa Administrative Code</a> §681-1.7 needed to be updated to reflect this change and the issue was unintentionally not addressed. UNI collected the increased fee of \$40 for FY 2008 and proposes to maintain the \$40 application fee for FY 2009. The Board Office will prepare and file the proper filings with the Administrative Rules Committee to effect this change.
