Action Requested: Consider recommending approval of two project descriptions and budgets: **Lincoln Way, Union Drive, Knoll Sidewalk Paving Improvements** (\$110,000) and **Lincoln Way, Union Drive – Knoll Landscape Improvements** (\$95,000).

Executive Summary: The University requests approval of two project descriptions and budgets. Both projects would support the various events and educational activities that occur at the Knoll; the south and west areas of the grounds have not had substantial improvements or renovations over the last 50 years. The grounds and first floor of the Knoll are primarily used for University supported events. Over the course of a year, several thousand individuals attend events there. As predominantly public space, the University is responsible for maintaining the area. The projects would be funded by gifts to the ISU Foundation; no general university funds including state appropriations or student fees would be used to fund the projects. The master plan for the work is included as Attachment A; the proposed garden zones are shown in Attachment B.

Board Policy (9.07G) requires institutions to obtain the Board's approval prior to initiating any renovation, modification, or improvement to the official state-owned residence of an institutional head if the cost is estimated at \$10,000 or more.

The **Lincoln Way, Union Drive, Knoll Sidewalk Paving Improvements** project would improve the accessibility and safety at the northwest corner of Lincoln Way and Union Drive and the Knoll. Access and paths in this area, which is a major campus entryway, need repair and replacement. The scope of the work would include improvements and repair of existing sidewalks and patios, and minor lighting improvements; the improvements and repairs would reduce potential slip and fall conditions. The project, with a budget of \$110,000, would be implemented as funds become available.

The **Lincoln Way, Union – Knoll Landscape Improvements** project is a multi-year effort to improve landscaping at the Knoll. The five acres that surround the residence need rejuvenation. Some plant materials have deteriorated or are approaching the end of their life expectancies. Areas are overgrown, aged limbs and tress could present safety hazards in high winds and storms. The scope of work would include general plan removal and replacement, bed preparation and minor lighting improvements. The project budget is \$95,000.
