FISCAL YEAR 2017

The regulatory objectives of the Board of Regents, State of Iowa, include the following:

detailed in the Board Strategic Plan for 2016 - 2021

Adoption of rules only after public comments are solicited and considered Adoption of rules that are clear and understandable to constituents

The administrative rules of the Board of Regents, State of Iowa, are reviewed regularly and generally are not amended unless a specific need arises either through Board action or legislation.
