## **Recommended Action:**

## **Executive Summary:**

Employee alleges unfair treatment by institution

 The Board has before it a confidential exhibit provided by the employee addressing the confidential personnel issues involved in this appeal.

Institution investigated allegations

 The institution has investigated the complaint of the employee and has determined that no change in the institutional decision should be made.

Employee appeals to Board

 The employee has exhausted the employee's appeal rights at the institution and seeks to have the Board provide a result different than the institution has provided.

Due process requirements met

 A review of the record before the Board provides evidence that the institution followed appropriate procedures and provided the employee due process.

Judicial review of decision possible

- A decision affirming the final institutional decision before the Board will represent final agency action. Following final agency action the employee may seek judicial review as permitted by law.
- Based on the record before the Board, the Board Office recommends that the Board affirm the final institutional decision in this matter.
