(URBANDALE) – On behalf of the Board of Regents, I want to express my thanks and appreciation to Governor Branstad for taking final action Friday on bills that greatly affect Iowa's public universities and special schools. We are very pleased that the Governor's action solidifies a tuition freeze for a second straight year for resident, undergraduate students at Iowa's public universities, while also maintaining commitments to ongoing capital projects.
