REQUEST FOR UPDATE TO UNIVERSITY PEER GROUPS

Executive Summary: In 2014, the Board of Regents approved a list of peer institutions for each university to use for reports to the Board. As institutions of higher education evolve with the times, it is appropriate to review and update these lists periodically. The universities each request updates as listed below.

University of Northern Iowa

The University of Northern Iowa requests approval to modify its group of peer institutions. The current set of peers was selected in 2014 using a collaborative, data-informed process involving various campus stakeholders. The 2023 proposed list of institutions was chosen using the same methodology as in 2014, taking into consideration a variety of high-level institutional characteristics (e.g. institution size and types of degrees offered) as well as specific variables like tuition, in-state vs. out-of-state enrollment, student financial need, number of full-time faculty, and total operating budget.

The proposed list includes four institutions in the current UNI peers list and six new institutions that more closely align with the metrics that distinguish UNI and make the institution stand apart from other regional comprehensive institutions in the country.

University of Iowa

At the request of the Board of Regents, State of Iowa, the University of Iowa performed an evaluation of its official Peer Group during the fall 2022 semester. This evaluation included assessments of a variety of relevant parameters among the university's peer AAU institutions, including student selectivity and success, faculty considerations, financial metrics, and R&D expenditures.

In an effort to more closely align the university with peers who are comparable across a range of metrics while also maintaining a set of aspirational peers, the University of Iowa requests that the University of California, Los Angeles, and the University of Texas, Austin, be removed from the official Peer Group, and replaced by Michigan State University, East Lansing, and the University of Utah, State Lake City.

Iowa State University

Iowa State University of Science and Technology requests approval to modify its group of peer institutions. Iowa State’s current list of peers was created in 1986 and has been updated only once since that time, by changing one university on the list.

An internal advisory committee with campus representation, led by the Senior Vice President and Provost, developed the updated set of peer institutions listed below whose missions and strategic goals more closely align with Iowa State. A variety of institutions and indicators were reviewed and considered, including enrollment, mix of academic programs, research expenditures, endowment, tuition, admissions selectivity and graduation rates.

In the recommended update, all the proposed peers are land-grant and Carnegie Classification Very High Research (R1) institutions. Three current peers would continue in the group, and seven are new.
