PROPOSED MISCELLANEOUS FEES

Actions Requested: Consider the proposed changes to miscellaneous fees for FY 2007 as illustrated on page 2.

Executive Summary: The Board reviews miscellaneous fees for the coming academic year after it has acted upon tuition rates. Approval of these fees is scheduled for Board action at its May meeting.

Miscellaneous fees include both tuition-related and non-tuition-related fees.

- Tuition-related fees are presented with the Board's annual discussion of tuition and mandatory fees and include items such as continuing education courses and workshops. These fees are in lieu of tuition.
- Non-tuition-related fees are presented in the spring timeframe when the Board discusses room and meal rates. Non-tuition-related fees include a variety of items such as course delivery fees and private music lessons. In each category, students pay only the miscellaneous fees that apply to them, with variances, in type and amount dependent on each student's program, needs, and interests. These fees are in addition to tuition.

For FY 2007:

- The University of Iowa requests five new fees ranging from \$15 to \$400 and increases in four fees ranging from \$2 to \$15.
- Iowa State University requests five new fees ranging from \$12 to \$1,886; increases in five fees ranging from \$2 to \$85; and the replacement of five specific fees from \$160 to \$408 to a range of \$160-424.

The proposed new Iowa State University fee of \$1,886 is for the College of Veterinary Medicine for all new students for a university-selected laptop computer and software.

- The University of Northern Iowa requests two new fees, \$30 and \$45; and increases in five fees ranging from \$5 to \$220.

University justifications for these new fees and changes are highlighted in Attachment A (pages 3-6) and a comprehensive list of all fees is contained in Attachment B (pages 7-11).

Background: Iowa Code §262.9(18) requires the Board to take action no sooner than 30 days after notification of the proposed changes in fees to presiding officers of each student government organization at each affected institution.

Regent Policy Manual §8.04 requires that the Board review and approve all new institutional or college-wide fees, all institutional or college-wide fees of over \$1 per semester, and all departmental fees over \$10 per semester.

The Board's policy encourages the three universities to continue to work together to establish common titles and amounts for miscellaneous fees. Some differences in fee titles and amounts may remain because of the unique nature of some programs and services at each institution.

The miscellaneous fees presented in this memorandum do not include regent-wide mandatory student fees approved by the Board in December with tuition rates or allocation of student mandatory fees developed by each university in consultation with its students which is brought to the Board for approval in May.

PROPOSED NEW FEES

- ◆ Establish a new fee of \$400 for the **Physician Assistant** program (Admission/Tuition Deposit Fees) to hold applicants' place in the class and help assure that individuals who accept positions will actually enroll. The fee will be applied to tuition if applicants begin the program and forfeited if applicants withdraw. The Colleges of Law, Dentistry, and Medicine (for medical students) have successfully implemented an admission/tuition deposit fee.
- ◆ Establish a new fee of \$100 for the **PharmD** program (Application Fees) to cover enhanced application/ admissions processing costs. The fee will be in addition to the standard University application fee. The College of Pharmacy currently admits students through the Pharmacy College Admission Service (PCAS) system, which is available through the American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy. After the College of Pharmacy determines which students are to be admitted, information is sent to the University Admissions Office for processing.

All colleges of pharmacy in the United States utilize the PCAS system and the majority of them charge an additional application fee. Fees ranged from \$20 to \$75 during the 2004 admission cycle and are anticipated to increase in the coming years.

- ◆ Establish a new **Nurse Practitioner Lab Fee** (College of Nursing Fees) of \$100 for graduate nursing students enrolled in the pediatric, adult/gerontologic, or family nurse practitioner programs to help cover expenses incurred in clinical-based education sessions.

The lab fee will enable the graduate program to continue providing hands-on clinical practice in the Pelvic Exam Model Program, a clinically-based session to train nurse practitioner graduate students with the psycho-motor aspects of the pelvic exam; and in a Clinical Skills Workshop, a two-day educational session focused on the acquisition of the most common clinical skills used by nurse practitioners such as suturing, splinting, casting, lesion removal, and joint injection.

- ◆ Establish a new **Student Professional Liability Insurance Fee** (College of Nursing Fees) of \$15 for student liability insurance for pre-licensure students in the BSN and Masters in Nursing and Healthcare Practice (MNHP) programs. Offering insurance through the College of Nursing will reduce the cost from \$30 to \$15 per year. All nursing students are required to have personal liability insurance. Nursing student leadership conducted a web-based survey of nursing students; 94.6% of the students support this annual fee.

- ◆ Establish a new, one-time **Web-Based Testing Fee** (College of Nursing Fees) of \$350 to cover costs and replace the previous method of assessing fees each time students register for particular courses.

The new fee will be assessed upon admission to the College, non-refundable, and phased in based on year of admission into the BSN or the Masters in Nursing and Healthcare Practice programs. Students admitted to either program starting in fall 2007 will be assessed the full amount; students admitted prior to that year will be charged a lesser amount based on their year of entry. Nursing student leadership conducted a web-based survey of nursing students; 80.8% of the students support this one-time fee.

UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

PROPOSED ADJUSTMENTS TO EXISTING FEES

- ◆ Increase **American Dental Association (ADA) Dues** (Dentistry Fees) from \$65 to \$67 for membership in the American Student Dental Association. The University reports that the national organization has increased the fee effective January 1, 2006.
- ◆ Increase the **Graduation Fee** from \$35 to \$50 to cover costs associated with licensing software and maintenance inflationary increases; providing materials and staff to review records and run graduation ceremonies; and upgrading to a server-based graduation analysis product from a mainframe version.

The University reports that the new server-based version will be easier to interpret and use; provide students with online capability to evaluate "what if" scenarios; have course articulation information more readily available to potential transfer students; and allow the University to estimate course demand for future semesters through linkage to the classroom scheduling system.

The graduation process involves staff effort to evaluate student records and ensure compliance with degree requirements. The process begins when a new student enters the University and continues through graduation. Updated graduation analysis materials are available to students on a 24/7 basis.

- ◆ Increase **New Student Programs/Matriculation Fees** from \$161 to \$175 to cover inflationary increases for materials and salaries plus an additional increase for expansion of opportunities and programming for transfer students. These fees are mandatory for all new students and pay for all programming expenses associated with orienting new freshmen, transfer students, and their parents to the University, and for enrolling students in their classes.

The University reports that it will offer expanded orientation opportunities for transfer students beginning in Spring 2007 as part of new agreements with community college students. The additional resources will be used to provide the new services and advising materials developed for these 2+2 students and any other "regular" transfers who wish to take advantage of early registration.

- ◆ Increase the **Transcript Fee** from \$10 to \$12 to support inflationary increases and a portion of the costs associated with implementing a new student record system. The University reports that the new system will improve web access for students and support development of a 24/7 on-line transcript request process for alumni that includes the possibility of same-day service through a third-party certification process.

IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

PROPOSED NEW FEES

- ◆ Establish a new, optional **Doctoral Dissertation and Master's Thesis** (Copyright Fees), services fee of \$45 for Ph.D. and Master's candidates to cover the U.S. copyright fee and the vendor fee for copies required by the copyright office. The fee will be optional for students that want this service, can be authorized on-line with a credit card when submitting the electronic thesis, and the amount will be established by the vendor.
- ◆ Establish a new **Key/Access Card Replacement Fee** of \$20 to recover the actual administrative, material, and labor costs associated with replacing a key or access card.
- ◆ Establish new **Publication Fees** to cover microfilming, web access, distribution, archiving, and publication in Dissertation Abstracts International for Doctoral Dissertations (\$55); and to cover microfilming and archiving for Master's Theses (\$45). These fees are in addition to the thesis fee.
- ◆ Establish a new **Veterinary Medicine Mobile Computing Fee** of \$1,886 to implement the College's mobile computing initiative that provides a university-specified tablet laptop computer and required software to each student. The University reports that the initiative will ensure that students have the most effective and efficient learning experience possible and are prepared to use current technologies. The fee will be charged to entering first-year veterinary medicine students. To guarantee compatibility, the University plans to purchase the computers.

PROPOSED ADJUSTMENTS TO EXISTING FEES

- ◆ Establish a range of fees for **Developmental Course Fees** from \$160 to \$424 and delete individual fees. These fees are intended to cover the direct costs of offering the course. The maximum fee for developmental courses will be set at the two-credit undergraduate tuition rate.
- ◆ Increase the **Duplicate Check Fee** from \$20 to \$30 to deter requests for payments by check. This charge is waived if individuals sign up for direct deposit.
- ◆ Increase the **Graduation Fee** from \$35 to \$40 to support implementation of a new system that can deliver a degree audit through the web and give students more comprehensive, timely, and frequent information about progress towards their degree.
- ◆ Increase **Thesis Fees** (from \$70 to \$100 for Doctorate and from \$15 to \$100 for Masters) to cover costs associated with the change to electronic theses from hard copy and include part-time computer support, electronic thesis administration, and the salary for a thesis reviewer.
- ◆ Increase **Transcript Fees** from \$10 to \$12 to cover inflationary costs.

UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA

PROPOSED NEW FEES

- ◆ Establish a **Duplicate Check Fee** of \$30 to cover the cost of creating duplicate checks and to encourage students to use direct deposit. This fee is waived if the student signs up for direct deposit.
- ◆ Establish a **Percussion Fee** (Price Laboratory School) of \$45 to replace instruments and parts for the percussion instruments used in the Lab School music program.

PROPOSED ADJUSTMENTS TO EXISTING FEES

- ◆ Increase the **Minimum Fee** (Developmental Course Fees) from \$408 to \$424 to match undergraduate resident tuition. Because this fee is tuition-related, it will be moved to the tuition-related-fee schedule in the fall and removed from the miscellaneous fees schedule next spring.
- ◆ Increase **New Student Programs/Matriculation Fees** from \$100 to \$125 to support new student programming, advising, and new initiatives with regard to student retention.
- ◆ Increase the **Instrumental Instruction Fee** (Price Laboratory School Fees) from \$10 to \$15 to cover the rising costs of instructional materials.
- ◆ Increase the **K-12 Fee** (Price Laboratory School Fees) from \$475 to \$500 to keep it competitive with similar community programs.
- ◆ Increase the **Nursery School Program Fee** (Price Laboratory School Fees) from \$1,080 to \$1,300 to provide adequate base funding. The University reports that funding provided by the state general fund and by fees is inadequate to meet increased fixed costs (salaries, supplies, etc.) The University reports that are competitive with similar community programs.
