⁽¹⁾ On August 12, 2010, the University submitted a comprehensive report, including a benefit-cost analysis, to FEMA outlining needed repairs and mitigation for the utility system (power plant, tunnels, and distribution system). In March 2012, the University received from the FEMA office in Des Moines multiple PWs providing insufficient obligations for repairs and mitigation. The University appealed these decisions in May and August 2012. On November 21, 2013, FEMA Region VII responded to the appeals and denied the comprehensive power plant flood mitigation plan including a protective flood wall. As discussed with the Board in February 2014, the University does not intend to appeal the FEMA decision on the proposed power plant flood mitigation wall structure.
