**Executive Summary:** Nearmyer & Associates, P.C. of Urbandale, Iowa, conducted an audit of Iowa Public Radio, Inc. to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

The audit report concluded that the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the net position of Iowa Public Radio, Inc. as of June 30, 2017 and 2016, and the changes in its net position and cash flows for the years then ended in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States.

Auditors did not identify any deficiencies in internal control considered to be material weaknesses and no instances of noncompliance or other matters were reported.



**Background:** Iowa Public Radio (IPR) (<http://iowapublicradio.org/index.php>) was created in December of 2004 by the Board of Regents to consolidate radio stations at the Regents universities and support the welfare and growth of the network of public radio stations in the state of Iowa. IPR is operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, and its mission is to inform, enrich, and engage Iowans through high quality news and cultural programming.

On behalf of the Board of Regents and the state universities, and consistent with Federal Communications Commission requirements, IPR manages day-to-day operations of the radio stations. This includes management, programming, and technical support of the public radio operations at the three Regents universities. IPR is primarily supported by contributions from the public.
