AGREEMENTS WITH THE NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Action Requested: Consider approval of the agreements with the Nebraska Department of Education as summarized below.

Executive Summary:

Academic Year Agreement – In May 1998, the Board of Regents and the Nebraska Department of Education entered into an agreement for the Iowa School for the Deaf to provide educational services to Nebraska students with hearing impairments. In accord with Iowa Code Ch. 270.3, the Board establishes the fee for these nonresident students. ISD currently has 14 Nebraska students enrolled at ISD.

The Board is asked to consider renewal of the education services agreement with the Nebraska Department of Education for FY 2024 at the rate of \$117,311 per Nebraska student (\$63,421 for academic and related program services and \$53,890 for residential services when applicable). The proposed FY 2024 rates remain unchanged from current year. Last year, both parties provided an intent notice to renew this agreement for FY 2024. These rates shall also apply to students from any other states that may enroll at ISD.

It is recommended that the Board, on behalf of the Iowa School for the Deaf, notify the Nebraska Department of Education of its intent to renew the agreements for FY 2025.
