 SUBJ: Approval of Miscellaneous Fees and Charges

Recommended Actions:

Approve changes to miscellaneous fees and charges for FY 2006 as shown in Attachment A beginning on page 9.

Executive Summary:

Policy In accordance with its Policy Manual, the Board reviews miscellaneous fees and charges for the coming academic year after it has acted upon tuition rates in the fall of each year.

Miscellaneous fees include both tuition-related and non-tuition-related fees.

- Tuition-related fees are in lieu of tuition charges and were approved in November 2004 with the Board's annual discussion of tuition and mandatory fees.
- Non-tuition-related fees are in addition to tuition charges. The fees presented to the Board in March for consideration are unchanged and are presented this month for approval. .

Non-Tuition Related Fees Non-tuition related fees include a variety of items ranging from course delivery fees to private music lessons. In each category, students pay only for miscellaneous fees and charges that apply to them, with variances in type and amount dependent on each student's program, needs, and interests.

SUI The University of Iowa requests approval for four new fees for FY 2006 ranging from \$10 to \$300; increases in five fees ranging from \$6 to \$1,500; and the elimination of one fee.

ISU Iowa State University requests approval for five new fees for FY 2006 ranging from \$5 to \$636; the elimination of five fees ranging from \$5 to \$85; and one name change.

UNI The University of Northern Iowa requests no new fees for FY 2006 and approval for increases in seven fees ranging from \$7 to \$30.

Background:

Iowa Code Iowa Code §262.9(18) requires the Board to take action no sooner than 30 days after notification of the proposed changes in fees and charges to presiding officers of each student government organization at each affected institution.

Regent Policy Manual Regent Policy Manual §8.04 requires that the Board review and approve:

- All new institutional or college-wide fees.
- All institutional or college-wide fees of over \$1 per semester and all departmental fees over \$10 per semester.

These fees do not include course fees for payment for materials used, fees that represent returnable deposits, fees assessed for damage or breakage by individual students, and fees assessed to pay for services external to the university.

The Board's policy encourages the three universities to continue to work together to establish common titles and charges for miscellaneous fees and charges.

Some differences in fee titles and charges may remain because of the unique nature of some programs and services at each institution.

Background Checks	<p>At its meeting in March, the Board questioned whether the Regent institutions require background checks for sensitive academic and employment areas with risk potential.</p> <p>The universities collectively reported that criminal background checks have been standard practice for many years for students pursuing teaching careers. Additionally, hospitals and intern programs are increasingly requiring background checks for both students and employees.</p> <p>A national database has not been developed to assist with background checks. The universities currently work with vendors and local law enforcement such as the Iowa Division of Criminal Investigation, which performs criminal history checks, but their database applies to Iowa information only.</p>
SUI	<p>The University of Iowa reported that it conducts criminal background checks related to academic and employment purposes. Policies and procedures for background checks are being developed and will balance student interests, patient safety, and liability.</p> <p>Since 2004, background checks have been required of students having patient contact at UIHC. With regard to employment, certain areas on campus are requiring and completing background checks such as UIHC, College of Medicine, Department of Public Safety, Information Technology Services, Hygienic Lab, Department of Psychology, and the University's utility system.</p>
ISU	<p>Iowa State University reported that individual departments and units decide whether to conduct academic and employment background checks. The University has not centralized this process.</p> <p>University admissions applications ask questions regarding conduct and request that applicants who respond affirmatively authorize ISU to perform additional background checks. With regard to employment, ISU reported that individual departments seek authorizations and perform background checks but a University policy has not been established.</p>
UNI	<p>The University of Northern Iowa reported that they currently perform background checks on employees in certain classifications and positions such as public safety officers, child care workers, certain information technology positions, cashiers, human resource staff and certain executive positions. There are no current plans to perform uniform background checks on all employees or students.</p>
ISD / IBS	<p>Both of the special schools perform criminal background checks for new hires.</p>

University of Iowa

NEW FEES The University of Iowa requests approval for the addition of the following non-tuition-related fees:

Arts and Cultural Events Fee Establishes a new arts and cultural events fee for all undergraduate students in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences to help support performing arts and cultural events that are sponsored by the highest ranked and most prestigious academic programs in the college; and central to the liberal arts education offered to all students. The fee will be charged per semester. Funds will be used to:

- Continue to offer a calendar of artistic/cultural events at no cost or substantial discounts to students;
- Perform needed maintenance and equipment renewal;
- Defray increasing costs of external performance venues such as Hancher Auditorium and Englert Theatre; and
- Restore operating budget purchasing power in regard to inflation.

Background Check (JCAHO) Establishes a new fee for criminal background checks for all students involved in patient care to comply with the Joint Commission on the Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO) recent requirement. JCAHO is UIHC’s accrediting body. The fee would provide a uniform means to support this required service.

Developmental Course Fees Establishes a new fee for the Teaching Assistant Preparation in English program, which offers teaching certification tests, non-credit courses, and other services for graduate students who wish to be hired as teaching assistants and whose first language is not English. The fee will help cover the costs of instruction and testing.

International Students and Scholars Establishes a fee for an English proficiency examination. All new students whose first language is not English must take this exam to determine whether their English skills are strong enough for regular courses or whether one or more English as a Second Language (ESL) classes are needed.

Revenue from the fee will be used to support development and maintenance costs for the test, which is given to approximately 350 students annually. The test includes a 30-minute writing section, a 45-minute multiple choice section on vocabulary and reading comprehension, and a 15-minute interview with two ESL instructors.

Course Delivery Fees Eliminates the off-campus MPH degree (per credit) line. This fee was rolled into the tuition-related charges for College of Public Health and approved by the Board in November 2004.

Dentistry Fees Increases the instrument management system fee to support the new Dentistry curriculum and provide clinic/instrument modernization. This fee would be applied to incoming students only.

The University reports that there are several staff that directly support Instrument Management System (IMS) operations that are funded from sources other than IMS fees. The University would pay the salaries of these employees from the fee increase.

The University reports that the College of Dentistry is:

- Incorporating two new courses: Implants and Pediatric Dentistry Technique. Both courses require additional equipment and materials to introduce students to these disciplines;
- Focusing on dental procedures that can only be performed by a dentist, which will require outsourcing laboratory procedures as is typically done in private practice. Outsourcing will allow students to concentrate on those hands-on procedures that will directly impact their expertise;
- Keeping updated on proper sterilization practices and regulations;
- Replacing antiquated equipment that is no longer under warranty; and
- Pursuing equipping departments with machines for oiling handpieces to provide improved function and assure greater longevity.

Orientation Services Fee Increases the orientation services fee to help cover the inflationary increases of the two-day program that provides new students with the opportunity to have questions answered by staff, meet academic advisers, and register for first semester classes.

Developmental Course Fees Establishes a new foreign languages fee to fund salaries, course materials, and media for remedial instruction in French, German, and Spanish. The courses are designed as “review modules” for students that have prior study in a language and are preparing to take a 102-level course in the same language to fulfill the foreign language graduation requirement.

Placement Services Fees (By College) Establishes a new placement services fee in the College of Human Sciences for the costs of creating and mailing credentials files. Since the Colleges of Education and Family and Consumer Sciences are combining to become the College of Human Sciences effective July 1, 2005, placement services fees previously charged under the College of Education are being eliminated.

Registration Fees Establishes a new enrollment fee for graduate students that have no remaining coursework. Students in their final term would be assessed this one-time fee, rather than tuition since there is no coursework involved. The fee would cover resources that graduate students use in their final term such as consultations with faculty and meetings with graduate program committees, which are comprised of faculty.

Student Counseling Service No-Show Appointment Fee Establishes a new student counseling service no-show fee to students who fail to show up for a scheduled appointment or who cancel within two hours of the appointment start-time. The fee is intended to reduce no-shows and late-cancels, both of which negatively impact the productivity of therapists and the timely scheduling of other students seeking services. Money collected from this deterrent fee would be applied to more counselors, which will increase the number of available counseling hours.

Course Delivery Fees Eliminates the MBA course delivery fee. This fee was combined with a per-credit fee as part of tuition-related fees approved by the Board in November 2004.

Developmental Course Fees Increases the mathematics fee to be equivalent to the undergraduate per-credit tuition rate for two credit hours.

Placement Services Fees Eliminates the credentials fees. Since the Colleges of Education and Family and Consumer Sciences are combining to become the College of Human Sciences effective July 1, 2005, fees previously charged under the College of Education are being eliminated.

Praxis I Preparation Fee Eliminates the Praxis I Preparation fee. Students may now take an on-line simulated test to practice for the Praxis I examination free of charge.

Registration Fees Changes the name from Continuous Graduate Student to Doctoral Post Comprehensive to better represent the fee's purpose and the population to which it is assessed. This fee is assessed multiple terms to Post-Prelim Ph.D. candidates who have completed coursework and who are not required to register for additional credits or pay tuition while completing their dissertation.

NEW FEES The University of Northern Iowa did not request approval for any new non-tuition-related fees for FY 2006.

Applied Music Fees Increases funding to continue providing adequate instructional materials, performance support, and repair, purchase and upkeep of instruments.

Course Delivery Fees Increases funding to cover production and presentation costs for off-campus programs.

Developmental Course Fees Increases the mathematics fee to be equivalent to the undergraduate per credit tuition rate for two credit hours.

New Student Programs / Matriculation Fee Replaces the orientation services fee with the new student programs/matriculation fee and increase funding for a Peer Advocate Program, a new service to help students transition to the University.

The Program will train peers to respond to questions and concerns related to student life and services, prepare a welcoming DVD, and for salary and fringe benefit increases for staff members compensated from this fund.

Price Laboratory School Fees (annual rates) Increases funding to help offset increased third-party costs associated with providing drivers' education to Price Laboratory School students.

Student Counseling Service Maintains the Student Counseling Service Late/No-Show Appointment Fee. The University has been charging this fee and requests official approval from the Board.
