APPROVAL OF UNIVERSITY PARKING RATES FOR FY 2007

Action Requested: Consider approval of the proposed annual parking rate increases for FY 2007 at the three Regent universities and changes to UNI's parking violations as detailed in Attachment A beginning on page 2.

Executive Summary: The Board received a comprehensive report on university parking at the March 2006 meeting. Each university has parking systems that are self-supporting. User fees and fines support operation, maintenance, and capital improvements. The parking systems do not receive any state appropriated funds.

No changes have been made since March. Approvals requested for FY 2007:

- University of Iowa annual charges would range from \$46 - \$1,860;
- Iowa State University annual charges would range from \$37 - \$706, and the Memorial Union Ramp annual rate would be \$405; and
- University of Northern Iowa annual charges would range from \$20.50 - \$315 and all five moving violations would be \$35.

The universities also charge other rates such as hourly, academic year, and temporary.
