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**PROPOSED 2020-2021 TUITION AND FEES**

**Action Requested:** Consider the proposed tuition rates, mandatory fees, Common and University Specific Fees for the 2020-2021 academic year as outlined in this memorandum, effective beginning with the Fall 2020 session.

Final action is scheduled on the proposed rates for the June 2020 Board meeting.

**Executive Summary:** The COVID-19 epidemic is unprecedented. Like every other facet of society, our public universities have undergone massive disruptions, which affect all of our students, faculty and staff. Many decisions have been made and will continue to be made, following the guidance of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the Iowa Department of Public Health, and others.

It is important that our students, families and our institutions have as much financial predictability as possible. Therefore, it is recommended there be no increases in tuition rates or mandatory fees. All proposed tuition rates and mandatory fees are provided on pages 6-10. While the rates contained in this memorandum represent the 2020-21 academic year, the Board may re-evaluate the tuition and mandatory fee rates for the Spring 2021 semester later this fall as more information becomes available.

**Undergraduate Tuition**

The proposed 2020-21 base tuition and fee rates for undergraduate resident and nonresident students remain flat (0% increase) with the last academic year.

**Common and University / Program Specific Fees**

Common and University / Program Specific Fees are assessed only to students that use these services based on their programs, interests or needs. Students may pay one or more fees as presented in this memorandum for the direct costs associated with using additional miscellaneous services provided by the universities. These fees are separate from tuition and mandatory fees. Detailed tables of these fees are provided beginning on page 11.

No increases are proposed for the 2020-2021 academic year.

ISU proposes to reduce one fee as well as replace two separate fees with one lower fee.

**IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY**

**Study Abroad Fees**

- ♦ Administrative Fee.....\$105 to \$50

Rationale:

To ensure the cost is spread equitably to all study abroad students participating in a study abroad program regardless of which university entity manages the specific program.

Under the current structure, the \$105 Administrative Fee is assessed to only students on short-term, faculty-led programs (Academic College Study Abroad Offices.) Students on semester-long programs (Study Abroad Center) require the same support, including the study abroad registration system, study abroad emergency notification system, personnel time for registration, and the promotion and support of study abroad across campus.

There are approximately 1,100 students on faculty-led programs paying \$105. ISU proposes that 1,800 students from all study abroad programs pay \$50. This will reduce the amount collected from \$115,500 to \$90,000 and meet the funding needs of the Study Abroad Program.

- ♦ Center Fee.....\$350-\$600 to \$275
- ♦ ~~Program Fees – Fall and Spring Semesters~~ .....\$600 - ELIMINATE
- ♦ ~~Program Fees – Summer Session~~ .....\$350 - ELIMINATE

Rationale:

To decrease the Study Abroad Center Fee from \$350-\$600 to a flat rate of \$275. ISU reviewed the overall Study Abroad Center budget and determined that: (1) support required for the programs was the same regardless of the term; and (2) the fee could be reduced.

This fee is assessed to students participating in programs managed by the Study Abroad Program/Center. Funds are used to partially finance the cost of administering these programs, including program advising, program development, program promotion, and site visits.
