PROPOSED 2022-2023 COMMON AND UNIVERSITY / PROGRAM SPECIFIC FEES

Action Requested: Consider the proposed changes to Common and University / Program Specific Fees for the 2022-2023 academic year as highlighted in blue in the spreadsheets on pages 2-6. Justifications may be found on pages 7-12.

Executive Summary: Common and University / Program Specific Fees are assessed only to students that use these services based on their programs, interests, or needs. Students may pay one or more fees as presented in this memorandum for the direct costs associated with using additional miscellaneous services provided by the universities. These fees are separate from tuition and mandatory fees.

Final Board approval is required prior to implementation of the fee changes. Board action on these fees is scheduled at the next meeting. Adoption of these fees is subject to revision at a later date if cost recovery is different than the original estimate.

Background:

Board Policy Manual §1.6H: (1) requires the Board to review and approve all new institutional or college-wide fees over \$1 per semester and all departmental fees over \$10 per semester; and (2) encourages the three universities to work together to establish common titles and amounts for fees. Some differences in fee titles and amounts may remain because of the unique nature of some programs and services at each institution.

Iowa Code §262.9(19) requires the Board to take action no sooner than 30 days after notification of the proposed fee changes to presiding officers of each student government organization at each affected institution. Written notification of the proposed fee changes will be sent to the student government presidents at each of the universities.

JUSTIFICATIONS – COMMON FEES

UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

Application Fees (non-refundable)

- ◆ Undergraduate Domestic Student and Non-Degree Student\$40 to \$55

Rationale: To:

- Provide additional staff resources to evaluate student transcripts and make admission decisions. While this process is automated for most applicants, some student files are reviewed individually;
- Build a larger enrollment funnel that will help SUI establish momentum in new and growing markets to mitigate future demographic shifts;
- Expand campus visit programming to expose many parents and students to SUI’s campus and community;
- Remain relentless in the use of data and analytics to efficiently manage resources in meeting institutional enrollment goals;
- Support the institutional mission of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion through increased minority outreach, recruitment and programming;
- Extend the communication plan to interact with prospective students earlier during their sophomore and junior years of high school; and
- Seek to establish relationships with high school counselors around the country to help increase awareness, build brand recognition, and allow SUI entry into key markets with highly portable students while showcasing the campus and community.

- ◆ PharmD Student..... \$50 to \$0 – ELIMINATE

Rationale: To eliminate a potential barrier to the application process with the declining number of pharmacy school applicants. SUI reports the fee is also administratively difficult to collect given the use of the national, centralized pharmacy school application – PharmCas.

Continuing Education (per credit hour)

- ◆ Undergraduate (Resident, Non-Resident and International)\$349 to \$364
- ◆ Graduate (Resident, Non-Resident and International)\$580 to \$605

Rationale: To be increased at the rate of the general tuition increase.

Lakeside Lab (per credit hour) (5 weeks)

- ◆ Undergraduate\$349 to \$364
- ◆ Graduate\$580 to \$605

Rationale: To be increased at the rate of the general tuition increase.

New Student Programs/Matriculation Fees\$250 to \$325

Rationale: To fund new programs implemented as well as inflationary costs for wages, goods, and services. This fee (commonly referred to as an “orientation” fee) was last increased in FY 2010. Since FY 2010, programs and services to prepare and welcome new students to SUI have grown significantly. SUI has implemented Onlowa, a five-day comprehensive bridge program for all new students and expanded administration of the ALEK (Assessment and Learning Knowledge) entrance exam for students pursuing a degree in a STEM discipline.

IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

Application Fees (non-refundable)

- ♦ Veterinary Medicine Student.....\$75 to \$80

Rationale: To cover increased costs of administrative costs such as IT, personnel, and postage.

Continuing Education (per credit hour)

- ♦ Undergraduate (Resident, Non-Resident and International)\$348 - \$1,214 to \$363 - \$1,266
- ♦ Graduate (Resident, Non-Resident and International)\$564 - \$1,705 to \$588 - \$1,778

Rationale: To be increased at the rate of the general tuition increase.

These fees recover costs associated with providing continuing education to distance and off-campus learners enrolled in online programs. The ranges are flexible to ensure that costs associated with offering each program are recovered. The proposed ranges are equivalent to the standard per-credit resident tuition rate through the highest per-credit international tuition rate assessed at the undergraduate and graduate level, respectively.

Lakeside Lab (per credit hour) (5 weeks)

- ♦ Undergraduate\$348 to \$363
- ♦ Graduate\$564 to \$588

Rationale: To be increased at the rate of the general tuition increase.

UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA

Application Fees (non-refundable)

- ♦ Reentry Fee.....\$20 to \$0 – ELIMINATE

Rationale: To remove a potential barrier in future years for students who would like to re-enroll after a multi-semester lapse in enrollment.

Continuing Education (per credit hour)

- ♦ Undergraduate (Resident, Non-Resident and International)\$325 - \$771 to \$339 - \$804
- ♦ Graduate (Resident, Non-Resident and International)\$517 - \$1,108 to \$539 - \$1,155

Rationale: To be increased at the same rate of the mandatory technology fee.

- ♦ Technology Fee\$38 to \$40

This fee is charged by the Office of Distance Education. Because of increased reliance on technology due to the pandemic, these fees will support an array of technology (e.g., software, quality classroom cameras and speakers) for distance students.

Developmental Course Fees.....\$176 - \$639 to \$183 - \$666

Rationale: To be increased at the rate of the general tuition increase.

Lakeside Lab (per credit hour) (5 weeks)

- ♦ Undergraduate\$325 to \$339
- ♦ Graduate\$517 to \$539

Rationale: To be increased at the rate of the general tuition increase.

JUSTIFICATIONS – UNIVERSITY / PROGRAM SPECIFIC FEES

UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

Tippie College of Business

Extension Courses (per credit hour)

- ♦ MBA for Professionals & Managers\$700 to \$750
- ♦ Graduate Certificate – Business Analytics\$700 to \$750
- ♦ Master of Science – Business Analytics\$700 to \$750

Rationale: To cover increased program delivery expenses, including faculty and staff costs and new technology to support online learning. SUI reports that even with the proposed increased program fee, the Professional MBA remains cost-effective and among the lowest cost programs as compared with peer institutions. These fees were last increased in Fall 2019.

Students move between the MBA for Professionals & Managers and Business Analytics programs and take courses in both programs seamlessly so it is necessary to have consistent fees.

Additionally, as the College of Business proposes the launch of an online MS in Business Analytics Program (Agenda Item I.C - Tuition and Fees) for a Fall 2022 start, SUI proposes implementing the increased program fees from \$700 to \$750 to correspond with that timing.

- ♦ CIMBA (Consortium Institute for Management and Business Analysis)
 - ♦ Undergraduate.....\$349 to \$364
 - ♦ Graduate.....\$580 to \$605

Rationale: To be increased at the rate of the general tuition increase.

College of Dentistry

- ♦ American Student Dental Association Dues.....\$88 to \$93

Rationale: This amount is a pass through of the dues increase approved by the national association. Dues support career resources, licensure reform efforts, and website access.

College of Dentistry

UI REACH Program

Rationale: To keep up with increasing costs, meet student needs, and enable the Realizing Educational and Career Hopes (REACH) program to expand services to students. This will be the first rate increase since the 2019-2020 academic year.

The goal is to ensure the program has adequate financial support to cover program costs while keeping REACH as affordable as possible. REACH postponed planned program increase requests for the past two academic years due to the financial hardships families may have experienced due to COVID.

Annual Program Fees provide the necessary financial support for an essentially self-sufficient REACH program and cover the following: personnel, operations, curriculum and program development, marketing, program evaluation and REACH course instruction expenses. Its budget also includes expenses associated with internship development, web-based and on-site post-program follow-up activities, and support of the student alumni group.

A critical component of this program is developing relationships with families and students across time and maintaining a low student to instructor ratio to provide the support needed for student success.

REACH is approved as a Comprehensive Transition Program by the Department of Education, allowing REACH students to apply for federal Pell grants, thus making the REACH program more affordable. Further, through the generosity of donors, REACH is able to offer partial scholarships to students with financial need.

The REACH Program is a unique transition certificate program for college students with disabilities, such as autism, intellectual disabilities, and learning disabilities. REACH empowers young adults to become independent members of the community. Coursework, campus life and career experiences prepare students to reach their full potential.

Students can enroll in the program for up to four years with early graduation options after year two. Students live in university housing, take a full course load, further develop independent living skills, and work at a variety of community internships.

The program is open to both Iowa residents and non-residents. The percentage of resident and non-resident UI REACH students fluctuates annually, most recently averaging between 30% - 40% residents, and 60% - 70% non-residents.

Quality programming and the required support for students with complex disabilities necessitates a skilled staff, which the program maintains at a staff to student ratio of less than 1:3. REACH employs approximately 26 undergraduate student mentors to assist with classroom support and campus life. The program employs student Resident Assistants (RAs) and two evening staff for the two-year program to support REACH students in the residence halls so that access to staff is available 24/7.

Applicants who have accepted an offer for a position to enroll in that college may subsequently change their mind and withdraw, sometimes as late as the first day of classes. Late withdrawals can result in unfilled spaces or the need to ask an alternate candidate to make a hasty move to Ames with little time to make arrangements for financial aid, housing, or books.

◆ Mobile Computing Fee\$2,550 to \$2,650

Rationale: To cover the increased costs of tablets and required software for all entering first-year veterinary medicine students. This fee is charged to all entering first year Vet Med students to support the college's mobile computing initiative and covers tablet PC and required software. This initiative ensures students have the most effective and efficient learning experience possible and enter the workforce prepared to use current technologies.
