

Des Moines, Iowa  
August 18 and 19, 1952

A meeting of the State Board of Education was held in the Fort Des Moines Hotel, Des Moines, Iowa, at 7:30 p.m., August 18, 1952, and in the Board's Office in the State Office Building on August 19, 1952.

PRESENT:

August 18 and 19, 1952: Mrs. Archie, Mr. Hagemann, Mr. Munger, Mr. Plock, Mr. Rider, Mr. Rupe, and Mr. Stevens, members of the State Board of Education; and Mr. Dancer and Mr. Gernetzky, members of the Finance Committee.

August 19, 1952, only: Senator Colburn, Senator O'Malley, Senator Augustine, Mr. Palmer, Mr. Kuester, Mr. Loss, Mr. Goode, Senator Fishbaugh, Senator Knudson, and Mr. Hanson, members of the Budget and Financial Control Committee.

The following business was transacted on August 19, 1952:

LEGISLATIVE ASKINGS, 1953-1955. There were general discussions by Mr. Rider, Mr. Plock, and Mr. Gernetzky about the basic questions relating to the legislative askings of the State Board of Education for the biennium that will begin

July 1, 1953, such as the probability of inflation, enrollments, and the use of reserves by the institutions.

During the afternoon the Repairs, Replacements and Alterations programs were discussed, and it was suggested by the Committee that recurring repairs should be taken care of first, and then the major replacements and alterations.

NEW PROGRAMS. New programs at the state institutions of higher learning were discussed as follows:

President Friley explained the needs for new programs and the expansion of existing programs at the Iowa State College in the fields of Research and Extension.

Provost Davis told about the needs for expanding programs at the State University, especially in Medicine, Nursing and Geriatrics.

President Maucker discussed the needs for expanding the program in Elementary Teacher Training at the Iowa State Teachers College.

#### ICWA STATE COLLEGE

The following business pertaining to the Iowa State College was transacted:

SCIENCE BUILDING ADDITION. There was considerable discussion about the State Board of Education renewing its request to the Budget and Financial Control Committee for approval of the construction of the Science Building Addition and the allocation of funds for that purpose.
