IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY PRESIDENTIAL SEARCH

Action Requested: Receive the report of the first ISU Presidential Search Committee meeting.

Executive Summary: The first meeting of the ISU Presidential Search Committee was held on Wednesday, June 29. Dan Parker and Ryan Crawford of Parker Executive Search, the firm selected by the Board for the presidential search, were in attendance. Regents Mulholland and Rastetter, members of the committee, were also in attendance.

Board of Regents President David Miles reviewed the charge of committee as had been approved by the Board.

Regent General Counsel Tom Evans provided information about the open records and open meetings laws and discussed how those statutes affected the activities of the committee.

The committee reviewed and agreed with the core qualities as had been approved by the Board previously. The core qualities will be used in evaluating candidates.

The committee also discussed the advertisement for the position. Advertisements would be placed in Chronicle of Higher Education, Diverse Issues in Higher Education, Hispanic Outlook, Women in Higher Education, and placed on the ISU and Parker websites.

Dan Parker explained the search process and his firm's role to facilitate the search and to reach out to a diverse pool of candidates.
