PROPOSAL TO DISCONTINUE THE REGENTS COMMON APPLICATION PORTAL

<u>Action Requested</u>: Consider request to discontinue the Iowa Public Universities Application Portal. The Council of Provosts and Admissions Study Team support this request.

<u>Background</u>: On September 10, 2014, as part of its TIER study, the Board of Regents approved the student services business case (Business Case SS-05) recommended by Deloitte Consulting to create a common application portal for the three Regent universities. A work group consisting of representatives from the Board Office, the University of Iowa, Iowa State University, and the University of Northern Iowa subsequently met and developed the Iowa Public Universities Application Portal, which launched on July 1, 2015. As stated in the Board's June 25, 2015 press release:

The website, known as the Iowa Public Universities Application Portal, will provide new U.S. high school graduates with an efficient process for applying to more than one of Iowa's public universities. The Portal will guide students through application questions common to all three universities plus specific questions applicable to each school.

The Iowa Public Universities Application Portal was first available to students seeking to enroll for the fall 2016 semester and is currently housed on the Board of Regents' website (https://apply.iowaregents.edu/). Information about the Application Portal was distributed to the Iowa School Counselors Association and to Iowa school districts.

Despite outreach efforts, the Iowa Public Universities Application Portal usage numbers remain low, as does the percentage of Iowans that apply to more than one Regent university. Nearly 90% of resident applicants apply to only one of the three Regent Universities. The tables below show usage levels of the Application Portal, Fall 2016 – Fall 2019. Students continue to prefer to make application directly to each Regent university or through the National Common Application.

With all three Iowa Regent Universities now using the National Common Application - https://www.commonapp.org/ - students in the State of Iowa can apply to all three universities by completing this national application. Iowa State University, University of Northern Iowa and the University of Iowa as well as over 800 other colleges and universities have subscribed to the national Common Application; students across the country and internationally use this application when applying to more than one school. The national Common Application efficiently and effectively meets the needs of Iowa residents wanting to apply to more than one Regent University.

Given the low usage of the Iowa Public Universities Application Portal, the small number of students that apply to more than one Regent University, and the adoption of the national Common Application by all three Regent Universities, the Regent Universities Admissions Study Team recommends the discontinuation of the this portal.
