**REQUEST TO TERMINATE THE MASTER OF ARTS IN GERMAN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF IOWA**

**Action Requested:** Approve the request by the University of Iowa to terminate the Master of Arts in German in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.

The Council of Provosts and Board office staff reviewed the proposal and recommend approval.

**Description of program.** The Master of Arts (MA) in German has two concentration areas: German literature and Germanic linguistics. Former graduates in this area of study entered careers in education, government, foreign service and commercial enterprises.

**Reason for proposed termination.** The program has had no enrollment since 2009. This change is permanent.

**Effect on current students.** No students are currently enrolled in the program and there are no current applicants.
