The University of Northern Iowa Presidential Search and Screen Committee will hold a meeting on November 10-12 at the Hilton Hotel, 3800 American Boulevard East, in Bloomington, Minnesota.

The purpose of the meeting is to interview semifinalist candidates for the presidency of the University of Northern Iowa. In accordance with Iowa Code, interviews will be conducted in closed session and candidate identities will not be revealed. A total of six candidates will be interviewed; on October 26, the committee advanced seven candidates to the semifinal stage, and one candidate withdrew.
