PRESENTATION: UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS

Action Requested: Receive the presentation.

Executive Summary: Enrollment Management and Admissions leaders from all three universities will share highlights of the undergraduate university admissions landscape, including specific aspects of recruitment.

Presenter: Matt Kroeger is in his fifth year of serving as Associate Vice President for Enrollment Management at UNI. Matt started working in admissions as a student telecounselor while he was undergraduate at UNI, and his more than 20 years of admissions and enrollment experience includes roles at Idaho State University, where he served as Director of Admissions and Recruitment; the University of Iowa; Northern Arizona University; and Morningside College.

Kirk Kluver is the Director of Admissions at the University of Iowa. Prior to arriving at Iowa, Kirk was the Director of Undergraduate Admissions at another large public research University, the University of Alabama-Birmingham. He began his admissions career over 17 years ago at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln where he held a variety of roles in the Office of Undergraduate Admissions and later as the Assistant Dean and Director of Admissions for the University of Nebraska College of Law. He received a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln College of Business and a Master of Science in Family Financial Planning from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln College of Education.

Katharine Johnson Suski is the Director of Admissions at Iowa State University. Prior to leading ISU's admissions office, Suski was Director of Admissions at Southern Illinois University and worked in several other enrollment management roles there: admissions coordinator, campus visit coordinator, associate director of recruitment and interim director of undergraduate admissions. She earned a bachelor's degree in radio and television (1998) and a Master of Public Administration degree (2004), both from SIU.
