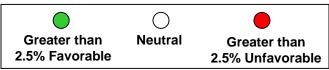

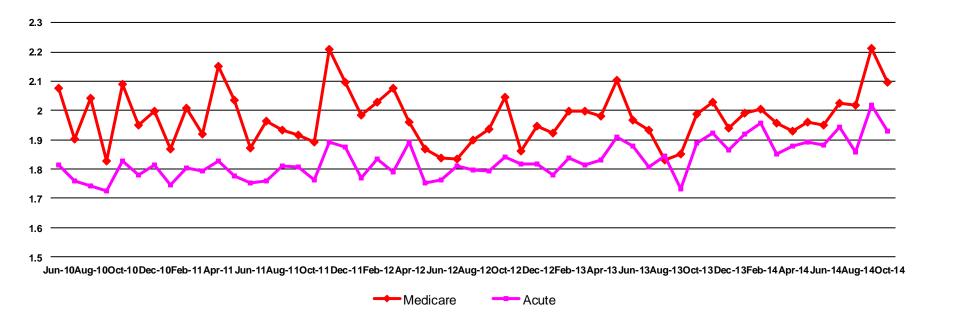

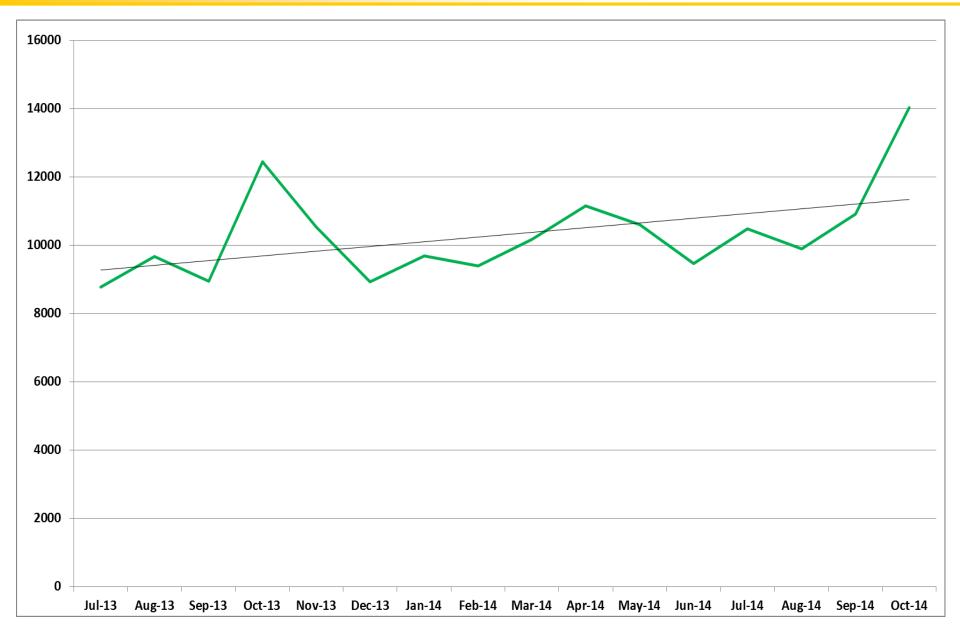

lowa River Landing Ambulatory Visits

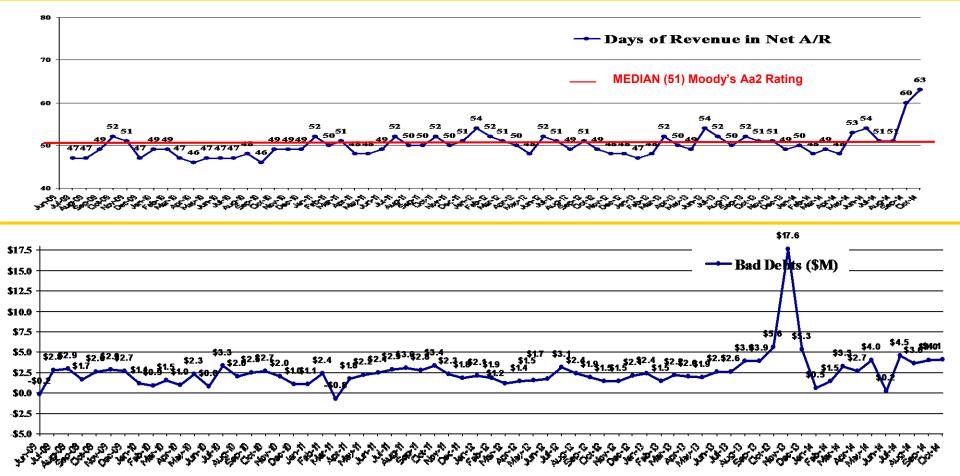
