



Fall 2007 - Fall 2016




Enrollment by Residency Status,

(Full-time and Part-time, first time in college students completing in 6 years or less)





All students (81%), Full-time students (92%)




# Undergraduate Time-to-Degree Has Decreased

(1991-2010 Entering Classes)




# U.S. Distribution of Higher Education Funding Sources, 2001-2016




# Trends in General Education Revenues by Source in Iowa

# Average 2016-17 In-State and Out-of-State Tuition and Fees at Public Four-Year Institutions by State






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# Iowa Regent Tuition Increases are Among the Lowest in the Country Over the Past 5 Years




# Institutional Aid for Undergraduates is Increasing Faster Than Tuition Growth

# Very Little State Financial Aid Support Aid to Regent University Students




# Decreasing Average Debt Load for Those Who Graduated with Debt 2010-11 to 2015-16
