ICCPHSE Meeting Minutes – Monday, April 25, 2016

1. Welcome—John Sellars, Chair

The Iowa Coordinating Council for Post-High School Education (ICCPHSE) met on Monday, April 25, 2016, at 10:00 AM at Graceland University. Chair John Sellars welcomed the Council members and guests to the meeting.

2. Call to Order and Introductions—John Sellars

Chair Sellars called the meeting to order. Council members introduced themselves. The following individuals were present:

3. Approval of Meeting Minutes—Jeremy Varner, Recording Secretary

Jeremy Varner presented the minutes from the October 28, 2015, ICCPHSE meeting for approval.

Action: John Sellars moved and Bill Rudd seconded for approval of the minutes as presented. Motion passed.

4. Treasurer's Report—John Sellars, Treasurer

John Sellars presented the treasurer's report. Sellars presented a statement of the Council's income and expenditures through March 2016. Sellars also stated a decision was made not to bill members this year.

Action: John Sellars moved and Jeremy Varner seconded for approval of the treasurer's report. Motion passed.

5. The Role of Liberal Arts in Postsecondary Institutions Panel

Bob Mesle, professor at Graceland University, Deirdre Heistad, Director of General Education at the University of Northern Iowa, and Laurie Adolph, Dean of Curriculum at Eastern Iowa Community Colleges, presented on the role of liberal arts in postsecondary institutions. The panel articulated how traditionally students' baccalaureate programs were 1/3 liberal arts, 1/3 major, and 1/3 elective but had shifted away from liberal arts in recent years. Bob gave an impassioned defense of liberal arts education citing its intrinsic value. Deirdre explained the liberal arts role in providing general, foundational education necessary for exploring a wider world and in developing critical thinking skills. Laurie discussed accreditation requirements, learning outcomes, various structures for general education, transfer issues, as well as the role of liberal arts in career-technical education. The Council discussed the value of liberal arts education and gaps between its value and political rhetoric.

6. M-SARA Update from the Iowa College Student Aid Commission—Julie Leeper

Julie noted that during its meeting on May 20, the Iowa College Student Aid Commission will be asked to adopt rules on postsecondary registration and exemption from postsecondary registration. ICSAC staff will recommend that the rules be adopted emergency and made effective immediately upon the Governor's signing of Senate File 2323. The immediate effective date will accommodate Iowa colleges that need to have applications approved for participation in the State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement (SARA) prior to July 1, 2016. Eight (8) Iowa schools have completed the full registration process and have been made eligible to participate in SARA. The proposed fee structure under the rule would require SARA-participating colleges to pay identical fees to Iowa and to SARA, except those that are exempt from registration.

7. Multi-State Collaborative on Military Credit Update—Diana Gonzalez, Permanent Secretary

Diana reported on the status of the Multi-State Collaborative on Military Credit (MCMC). She noted that two years ago the Midwest Higher Education Compact (MHEC) and 13 states put together a proposal to the Lumina Foundation to establish the MCMC. Its purpose is to bring together states to enhance the awarding of college credit for military experiences. Iowa was invited last year. An advisory team meets monthly. Gonzalez noted several challenges that have been identified and recent efforts to enhance the process.

8. National Governor's Association Future Ready Iowa Project Update—Doug Hoelscher, Iowa Director of State-Federal Relations; and Jeremy Varner, Administrator, Division of Community Colleges

Jeremy introduced the discussion of the Governor's Future Ready Iowa initiative and Director Hoelscher. Hoelscher provided an overview of the initiative including the National Governor's Association Talent Pipeline Alignment Policy Academy, the Governor's goal of 70% of Iowans obtaining postsecondary education or training with labor market value by 2025, the Future Ready Iowa summit, and other efforts. Following the presentation, there was discussion about efforts to enhance reverse credit transfer.

11. ICCPHSE Tools—Diana Gonzalez

Listserv:

Diana indicated that all personnel changes (i.e., contact information) to the listserv need to be provided to Laura Dickson. An email will be sent out to the listserv to remind recipients to inform the Board of Regents office of any listserv changes.

Taxonomy:

The Taxonomy is a list of programs offered at each institution. Diana asked the members to check their college's list and let the Board of Regents office know if there are any program updates, particularly if a program has been terminated.

12. Fall Enrollment Report—Diana Gonzalez

Diana provided an update on the ICCPHSE fall enrollment report. She noted that data would be collected in September and into October. Jeremy noted that community college fall enrollment reporting will occur one week later this fall. He also asked whether the group should consider collecting online nonresident enrollment to provide data to the ICSAC that could be useful in determination of SARA fees. It was noted that NC SARA currently uses full-time equivalent enrollment and Iowa piggybacks of it; the ICSAC will review actual costs after one year and revisit the fee issue. The topic was referred to the ICCPHSE executive committee for discussion at their summer meeting.

Jeremy provided an update on the Home Base Iowa report and provided information on the mandate and reporting expectations for next fiscal year.

13. Membership for 2016-17—Diana Gonzalez

Diana referenced the membership list and stressed that it is important the list be reviewed to ensure the right people are included. She requested that any changes to the list be submitted to her.

14. Confirmation of Chair and Vice-Chair—John Sellars

There was discussion about Daniel Kinney serving as chair of the ICCPHSE for the 2016-2017 academic year and Bruce Harreld serving as vice chair. The Council opted not to take action to permit further discussion of the vice-chair appointment.

15. For the Good of the Order—John Sellars

The Second Annual Campus Safety and Security Summit will be held on October 26, 2016, at Iowa State University and the next ICCPHSE will dovetail with that event. The first summit focused on Title IX and sexual misconduct and the second summit will expand into other topics. The meeting was adjourned.

3. Approval of Minutes—Jeremy Varner

Chair Sellars asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the April 25, 2016, meeting of ICCPHSE.

Action: A motion was made by Diana Gonzalez and seconded by John Sellars to approve the minutes. The minutes were unanimously approved.

4. Treasurer's Report—John Sellars

John Sellars presented the treasurer's report through June 30, 2016. No fees will be requested this year. John noted the council's account has \$2,600 and the ICCPHSE usually spends less than that annually. It was determined that the council can go at least one year without charging fees.

9. Notification of Changes to the ICCPHSE Listserv—Diana Gonzalez

Diana indicated that all personnel changes to the listserv need to be given to Laura Dickson. Dan will include a reminder of the importance of notifying Diana of changes to the ICCPHSE listserv in his letter to members. A reminder will also be included on the October meeting agenda

10. Membership for 2016-17—Diana Gonzalez

Diana requested that any changes to the membership list be submitted to her. Upcoming changes include the following:

- Student membership to be dropped.
- Iowa State Board of Education member and alternate to be named in August.

11. Fall 2017 Enrollment Report Data Collection—Diana Gonzalez

Dan's letter will include a reminder for institutions to participate in the ICCPHSE fall enrollment report which is important for policymakers. Data is due by the end of September, and the results will be finalized in October. Jeremy noted community college data will be submitted one week later than prior years due to changes to state reporting procedures. There was discussion about whether to capture nonresident online enrollment; the consensus view was to collect the data if the Iowa College Student Aid Commission requests it.

12. Fall 2016 Veterans Enrollment and Credit Report Data Collection—Jeremy Varner

Jeremy reported on veteran data reporting mandated as part of the Home Base Iowa initiative. Home Base Iowa is intended to help veterans make a smooth transition to civilian life in Iowa. The data reporting requirements support efforts to ensure veterans receive appropriate credit for prior military education, training, or experience. This year will be the second year of reporting and no changes are expected. Data reporting is on the aggregate level on five data elements and last year included five

fiscal years of data. All public universities, community colleges, and Iowa Tuition Grant eligible independent colleges and universities are mandated to report. The Iowa Department of Education is coordinating data reporting, but the final report will be a product of the ICCPHSE with review. Guidance has been provided to institutions and the deadline for data reporting is October 1. The department will bring summative data to the ICCPHSE at its fall meeting and distribute the final report electronically in November for review and approval. The final report will be provided to the Governor and General Assembly.

13. Home-Base Iowa (HBI) Initiative—Multi-State Collaborative on Military Credit Report Data (MCMC)—Diana Gonzalez

Diana reported that Iowa is participating in the Multi State Collaboration on Military Credit funded by Lumina. The purpose of the project is to develop and discuss practices while facilitate the application of military credit to veterans' academic programs. Many of the effort of the collaboration mirror and support the efforts of Home Base Iowa.

14. 2016-17 Vice-Chair

Diana reported that Jim Wohlpart, interim president at the University of Northern Iowa, has agreed to serve as vice-chair.
