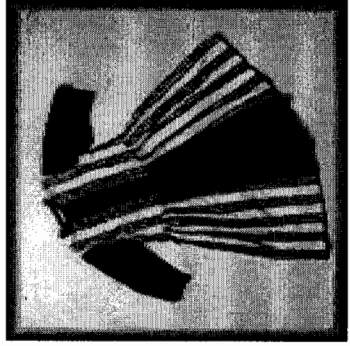
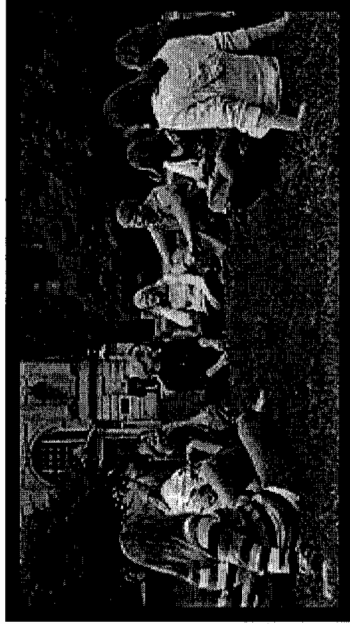


Goals

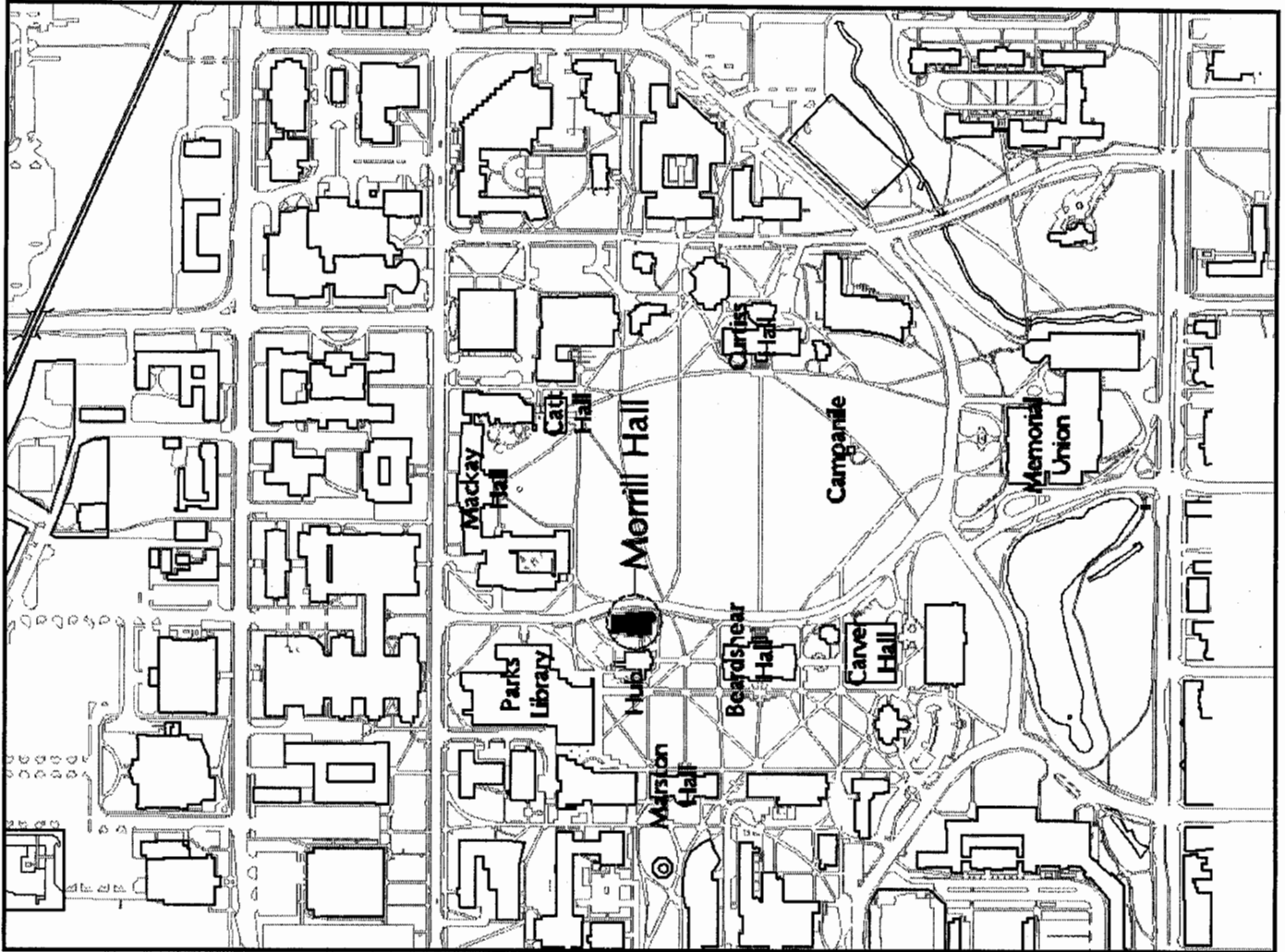

Site Plan

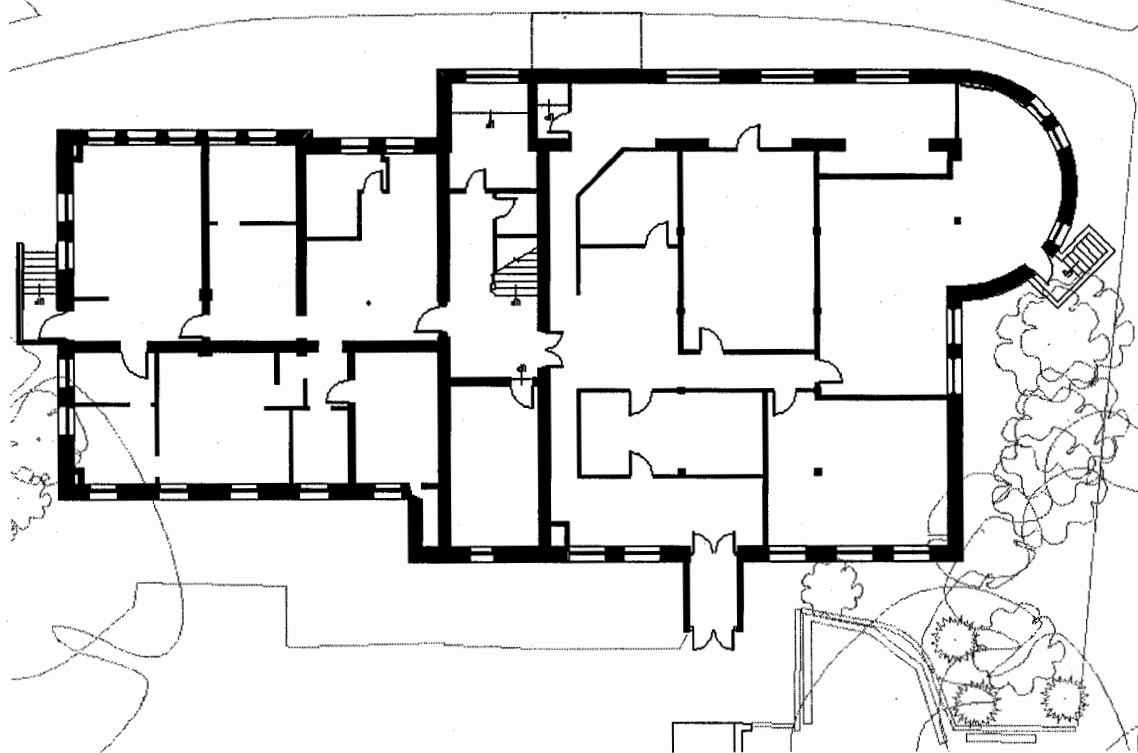




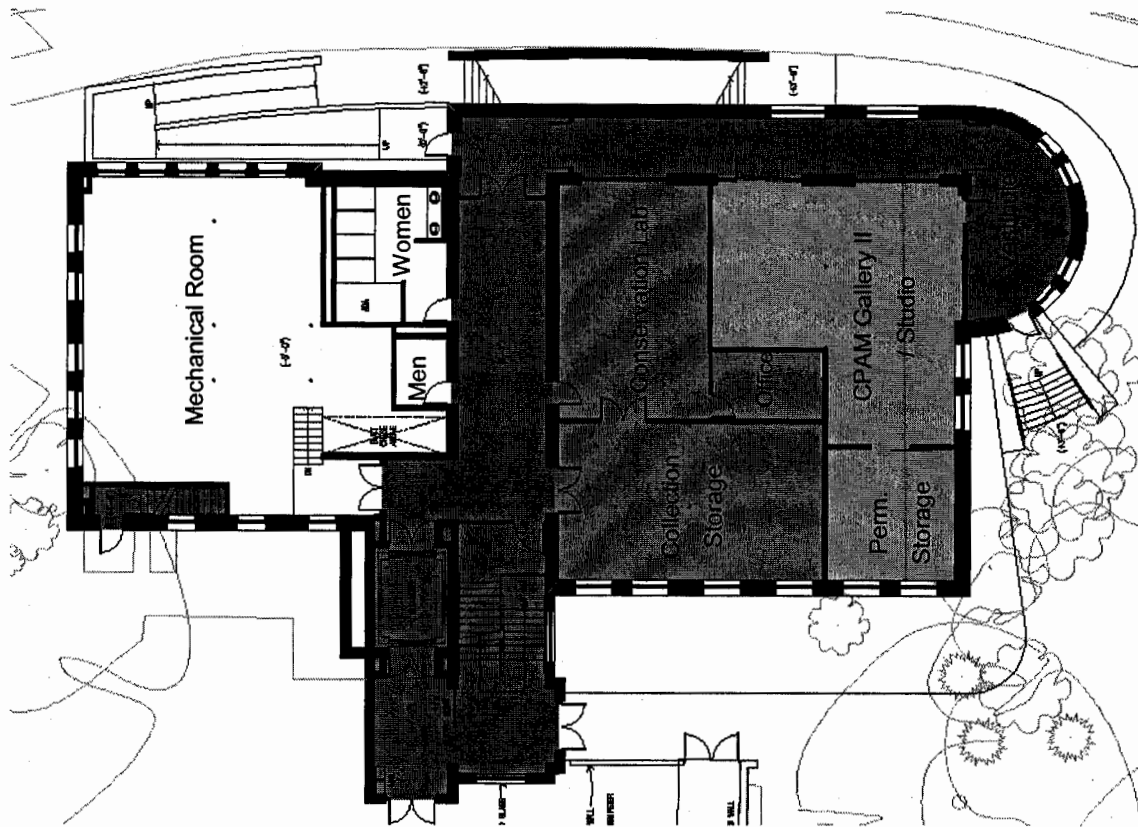
Morrill Hall - The Present

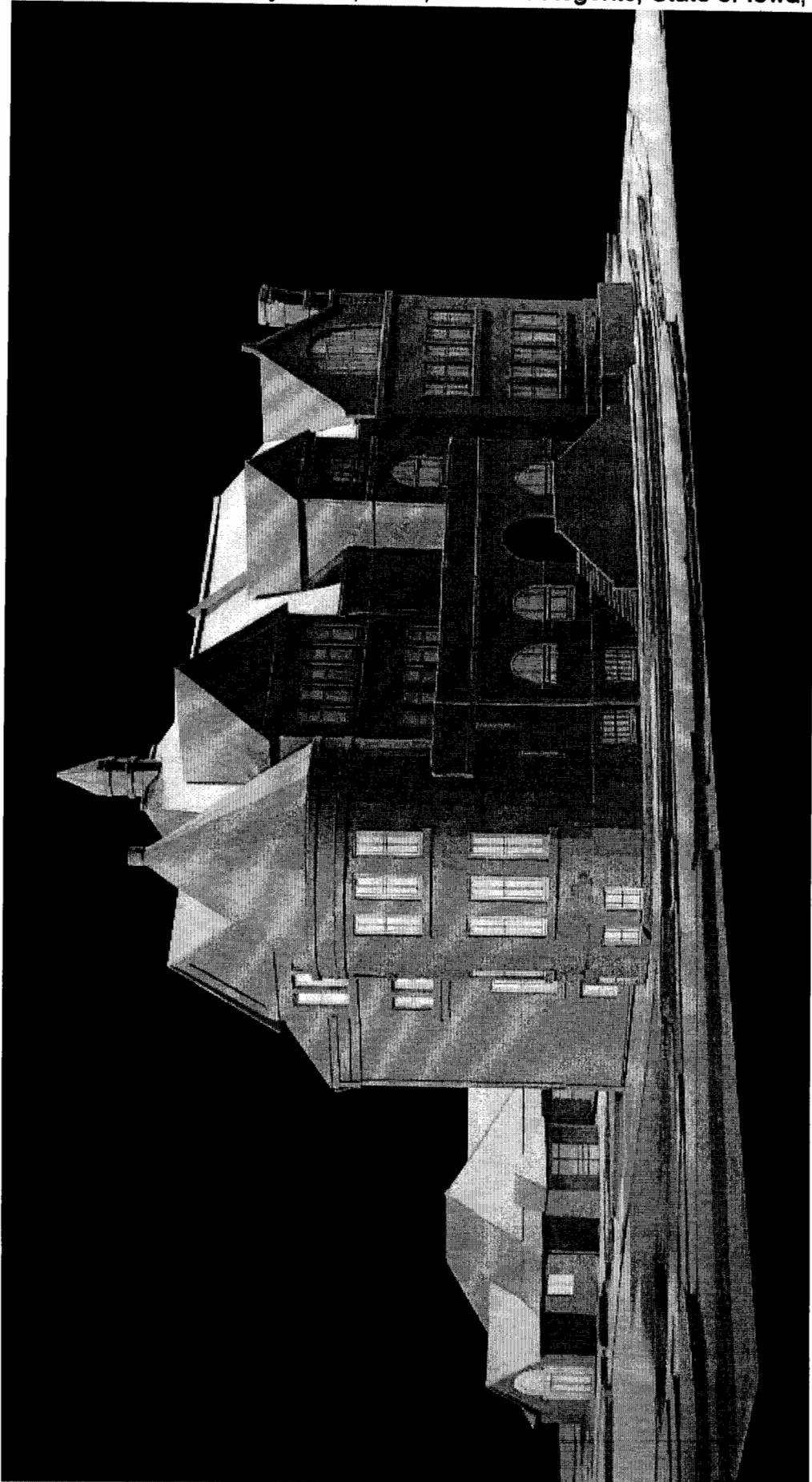
West Elevation
