Subject: Governor Culver quote

The following is a quote from Governor Chet Culver regarding the current investigation of an alleged sexual assault at the University of Iowa. This message was forwarded to our office by the Governor's staff yesterday evening. Public statements regarding the matter from Board President Gartner have also been posted on the Regents website.

“These are very serious charges that demand an immediate investigation. I expect it to be thorough, with complete cooperation from all involved, and with full respect given to the victim of any alleged criminal conduct. I also expect the University to quickly assess whether the right internal procedures were followed and to be forthcoming with the public about the results of that assessment at the appropriate time.”
