

A Message regarding the 2005 Iowa College and University Enrollment Report

The Fall 2005 Iowa College and University Enrollment Report, as compiled on behalf of the Iowa Coordinating Council for Post High School Education, contains a snapshot of reported enrollments at Iowa Postsecondary institutions.

Policy-makers, researchers, and others utilizing this data should be aware of the following facts related to this report.

1. The data in the report are based on voluntary reports from the institutions themselves (through the Iowa Department of Education in the case of the community colleges), to personnel at the Office of the Registrar at the University of Iowa who have been designated by the Coordinating Council as the collection agency for this information. The reporting institutions, therefore, are the source of the data.
2. The format of this report differs from past years, as the Council is attempting to move toward institutional categories more closely aligned with federal Department of Education reports. This effort is a work in progress, and as is illustrated in the footnotes, is not yet considered perfected, particularly as it relates to the category headed "Private for profit 4 year...", where some enrollment numbers may actually include students in programs with less than 4-year-approved courses of study." Further refinement of categories for the 2006 report may be considered by the Council in the months ahead.
3. There are two tables of information available, the first an institution by institution set of data, and the second a summary table that provides the aggregated data by sector.
