Subject: Approval of Parking Rates for FY 2001
Date: May 8, 2000

Recommended Action:

Approve the proposed FY 2001 parking rates at University of Northern Iowa as set forth on Attachment A.

Executive Summary:

In accordance with Board policy, any changes to traffic and parking regulations at the institutions are presented to the Board for approval.

At its April meeting, the Board gave preliminary consideration to the University's proposed FY 2001 changes to parking rates and regulations. The University's proposed parking rate increases range from \$.50 - \$15.00 annually; \$.25 - \$7.50, for second semester; and \$.15 - \$3.75 for summer. (Details on Attachment A.) The University also proposed two new fees: A parking fee of \$1 per 12-hour period, or part thereof, for conference attendees required to park in designated areas assigned by the University's Department of Public Safety, and a new yearly vendor service permit fee of \$100.

These changes will allow the University to continue supporting the comprehensive parking program. The proposals are unchanged from those presented in April.

The Board of Regents' strategic plan outlines its accountability objective in key result area 4. The Board is charged with exercising effective stewardship of the institutions' state, federal, and private resources. In this effort, the Board annually reviews institutional resources, such as parking rates, to assure consistency with the strategic plans of the Board and of the institution.

Proposed rate changes in charges and fees require statutory notice to students and a waiting period of 30 days before final approval. The University of Northern Iowa's student government president, located at the student government office as listed in the university directory, received notification on April 12, 2000, concerning the proposed parking fee increases.

Background/Analysis:


Iowa Code §262.69 allows the Board to make rules regarding policing, control, and regulation of traffic and parking on the property of any institution under its control.

The University of Northern Iowa parking system is a self-supporting operation, including maintenance and capital improvements on its facilities. The system does not receive state appropriations.


Parking user fees support the University parking operations, maintenance, and capital improvements. The University projects a \$22,000 increase in parking revenues from the increase in parking rates, ranging from 2.8% to 9.1%, and from two new proposed parking fees: Conference attendees will pay \$1 per 12-hour period, or part thereof, and will be required to park in designated areas assigned by the University's Department of Public Safety; Vendors will pay an annual fee of \$100 for service permits.

The additional revenue will be used to cover higher operating costs and repairs to parking lots across campus and to continue to implement the University's long range parking and traffic plan. FY 2001 total estimated fee revenue is \$500,000; total revenue for the University's parking operation is estimated at \$853,000.

The University Parking and Traffic Policy Committee reviewed and recommended these new and increased parking fees for FY 2001.
