Spring 2011 Enrollment Counts

Below are the official Spring 2011 enrollment counts from ISU, UNI, and SUI. The total Spring 2011 enrollment is 68,565 which is an increase of 1,176 (+1.7%) from last spring – all three universities had overall enrollment increases. There was an increase of 1,146 undergraduate students; an increase of 20 graduate students; and an increase of 10 professional students. The total number of lowa residents decreased by 171; the total number of nonresidents increased by 1,347.

UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

The total for SUI is 29,505, an increase of 616 (+2.1%) from Spring 2010. There was an increase of 646 (+3.3%) undergraduate students; a decrease of 18 (-0.3%) graduate students, and a decrease of 12 (-0.3%) professional students from the prior spring semester. The number of lowa residents decreased by 205 students (-1.2%); the number of nonresidents increased by 821 students (+6.9%).

IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

The total for ISU is 26,782, an increase of 499 (+1.9%) from Spring 2010. There was an increase of 362 (+1.7%) undergraduate students; an increase of 115 (+2.5%) graduate students, and an increase of 22 (+3.9%) professional students from the prior spring semester. The number of lowa residents decreased by 84 students (-0.5%); the number of nonresidents increased by 583 students (+6.4%).

UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA

The total for UNI is 12,278, an increase of 61 (+0.5%) from Spring 2010. There was an increase of 138 (+1.3%) undergraduate students and a decrease of 77 (-4.4%) graduate students from the prior spring semester. The number of lowa residents increased by 118 students (+1.1%); the number of nonresidents decreased by 57 students (-5.0%).
