# Comments Received as of Thursday, May 9, 2013

#### **Ethics**

1. Develop an ethics policy.

- 2. Conflict-of-interest standards be strengthened by prohibiting regent staff from having other financial dealings directly related to the state universities.
- 3. "Develop a clear ethics complaint process to enforce the Regents ethics policy."
- 4. Require timely submission of conflict of interest disclosure and publically post the information.
- 5. End the revolving door between public institutions and private corporations.

Also stated: Lobbyists who worked for a regent or that regent's business could not lobby for a school or program governed by the regents for two years after leaving that job.

### Public comment/meetings

- 6. Allow for a public comment period at each board meeting.
- 7. Hold four public hearings each year, one in each congressional district.
- 8. Make BoR committee meetings open to the public.

#### Other

- 9. Any board proposal costing at least \$100,000 would require public readings at two board meetings before action could occur.
- 10. Develop a policy addressing academic freedom and Board member activity.
- 11. Provide budget information that is easily accessible and understandable to students. (Cited: Federal Taxpayer Receipt)
- 12. Add a faculty member to the Transparency Task Force. Note: Dr. John Johnson is a UNI faculty member.
- 13. Review the relationship between the release date of the docket and the Board's policy for a request to appear before the Board.
