Value of Accreditation in Counseling Professions

Degrees from accredited programs are recognized by State Licensing Boards as meeting the educational requirements to obtain a license to practice.

Graduates from accredited programs have assurance that the academic credential will have career value and longevity.

Graduates from accredited programs are preferred by employers.

Top candidates for graduate study attend accredited professional programs.

Doctoral study in counseling professions typically require a Masters' from an accredited program.

Accreditation of Counseling Professions

AAMFT – American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy is the professional association for the field of marriage and family therapy representing the professional interests of more than 50,000 marriage and family therapists throughout the United States, Canada and abroad.

CACREP – Council of Accreditation of Counseling & Related Educational promotes the professional competence of counseling and related practitioners through the development of preparation standards; the encouragement of excellence in program development; and the accreditation of professional preparation programs.

CORE – Council on Rehabilitation is a specialized accreditation organization that is recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) and a member of the Association of Specialized and Professional Accreditors (ASPA). CORE accredits graduate programs which provide academic preparation for a variety of professional rehabilitation counseling positions
